NUNO MATOS WINS THE T2 SERIES WORLD TITLE WITH FEDIMA FA2, AFTER GETTING THE FIRST PLACE AT HUNGARY BAJA LAST WEEKEND

Nuno is the third Portuguese pilot winning an International TT competition
The World title was achieved after a brilliant result in Hungary Baja
Title consagracion in the Portalegre Baja in 28-30th of October



Four years, four titles...Two National T8 Series title in 2007 and 2008 and a T2 in 2009, the Portuguese pilot with 33Years only, confirmed this weekend the world title of the TT Baja FIA CUP in the T2 Series, after a fabulous first place in the Hungarian Baja.

This is the youngest Portuguese team achieve this goal in a FIA TT Championship. Once more, the Cetelem/ Fedima Team proved its superiority and ended the Hungarian Baja with an advantage of 22 points, leaving the second post with more than 15 Minutes behind.



"I have no words to express how it is to bring to Portugal such title in a kind of sport with so many fans in my country. It was something our team never thought about four years ago, when I was starting on the national championship of T8 Series". Says Nuno Matos, few minutes after celebrating with all his team at Hungarian Baja Podium.

"Today I'm living a dream and sincerely I can't wait to arrive in Portugal, to share all this joy with the people who have always supported us, my family, friends and sponsors. It is their title too, with no doubts the most important one among my short story at the TT competitions..." Said Nuno, the 33 years old pilot.

With four conquered podiums, Russia, Italy, Spain and Hungary, Nuno Matos confirms His stability in achieving always a title in each season of TT competition: The national titles are them since 2007 till 2009 in T8 and T2 series, by order.



Nuno Matos repeats something that only Rui Sousa and Carlos Sousa had accomplished. **“Two pilots which were always a reference to me, in National and International levels. It is a kind of competition were we discuss each rally starting from the same level with all the teams involved, with a lot of personal sacrifice on it. It was not an easy project to get ready. Truly, only with the help and work of everybody in the team it was possible to get through the obstacles and challenges that were always falling on our way during this year, it was a really unforgettable season”.** Says Nuno Matos.

“Now we just want to enjoy the moment and wait for the last rally, in Portalegre, from the 28th till the 30th of October. It is my birthplace and also without the pressure of getting points, everything will be easier. Even thought, our goal is to close the season repeating the victories in Portalegre of the two last years”. Promised Nuno Matos.
